

OUR CALL TO MINISTRY FOR THE ST THOMAS MORE FAMILY OF FAMILIES

Our ministry to proclaim Christ in the world is our mission initiated by our Baptism. The seed of faith is planted so that we can be nurtured by the Christian community and exercise our gifts as part of that community. Through Baptism we have been given Gifts of the Holy Spirit (*Isaiah 11 Verse 2*). Here the seed of our ministry, our vocation, was planted and is nourished in the Eucharist and strengthened at Confirmation, these being the Sacraments of Initiation. And from these gifts, fruits of the Holy Spirit develop (*Galatians 5 Verse 22*) for the good of the whole community.

St Thomas More Parish assembles as a baptised people under the leadership of the Archbishop and priests of the Parish as we seek to fulfil the ministry of Christ in this parish. Whenever we gather to celebrate the Eucharist on a Sunday, the Lord's Day, we recognise that all our ministries on behalf of the parish, and in our daily lives, find their origin in the sacred liturgy which is the summit and source of our lives as Catholics. We seek to promote the full and active involvement of all the People of God in the mission and ministry of our parish.

In the nature of things, some ministries are more noticed than others. Our Lord counselled his disciples to "Go into your room and pray privately", and much work that is done in the Parish attracts little attention and is quietly done in the service of Our Lord and the Church.
