John Kennedy began his working life as a teacher and education administrator and is a former Hawthorn (AFL) player and coach of their Premiership teams in 1961, and 1971 and 76. After his playing and coaching days, he was appointed Chairman of the Australian Football League Commission. He has since retired from the latter role.

Leading club figures have recently stated "The family club is not just a couple of words Hawthorn uses loosely. It is a phrase that encapsulates the very existence and spirit of the Club. That spirit is personified in one of our Legends of the Club, John Kennedy Senior. John has always been highly professional at everything he undertaken, so committed to the Hawthorn Football Club, but has a level of humility that makes him a role model for everyone associated with the Club."

Today John continually challenges himself. Over the years, he has successfully established a potato farm, learnt to speak Italian, taught himself Latin, and is currently teaching himself the organ.
